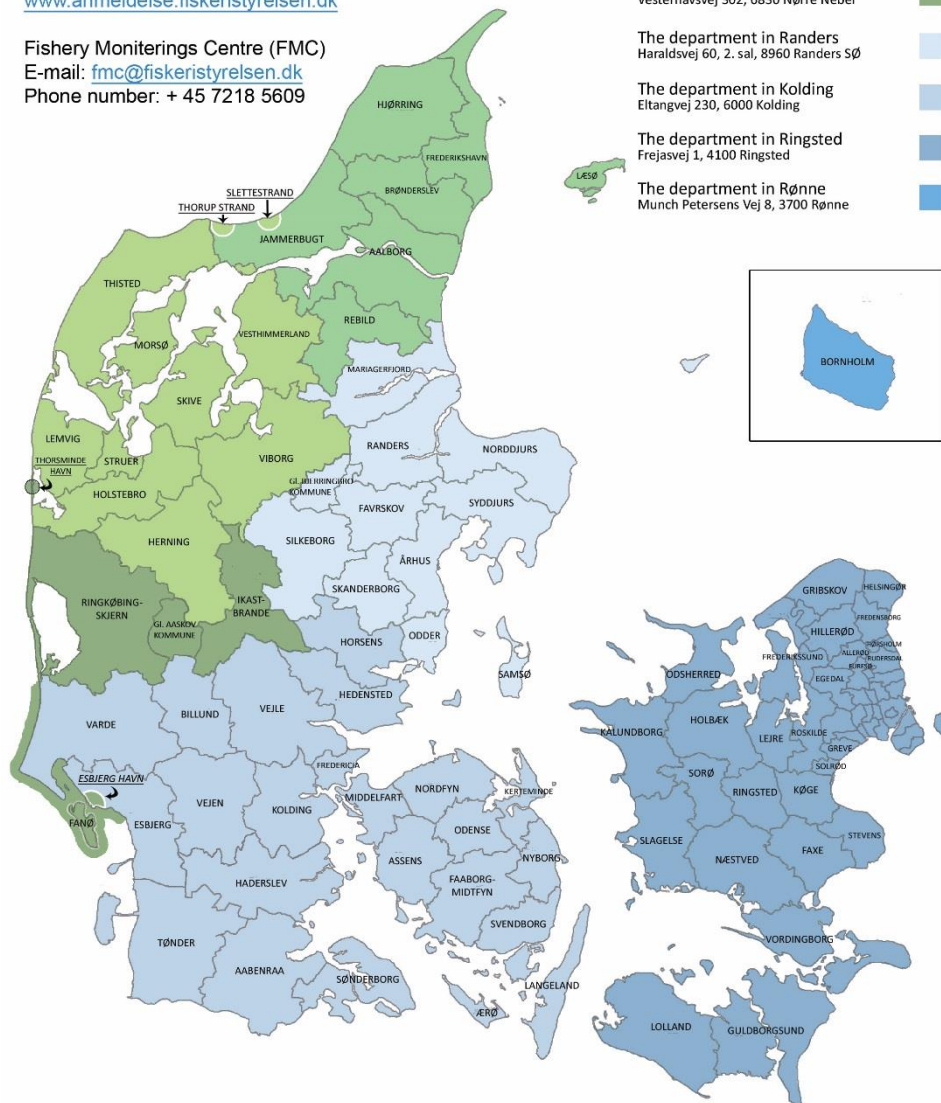

Regulations Information for catching Cod in the Western Baltic

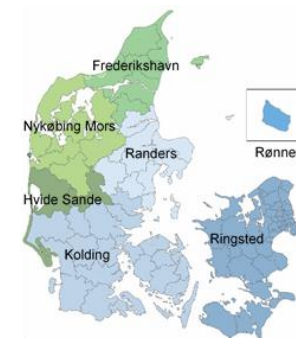


Catch limits of cod in the Western Baltic. Valid for angling in 2019.

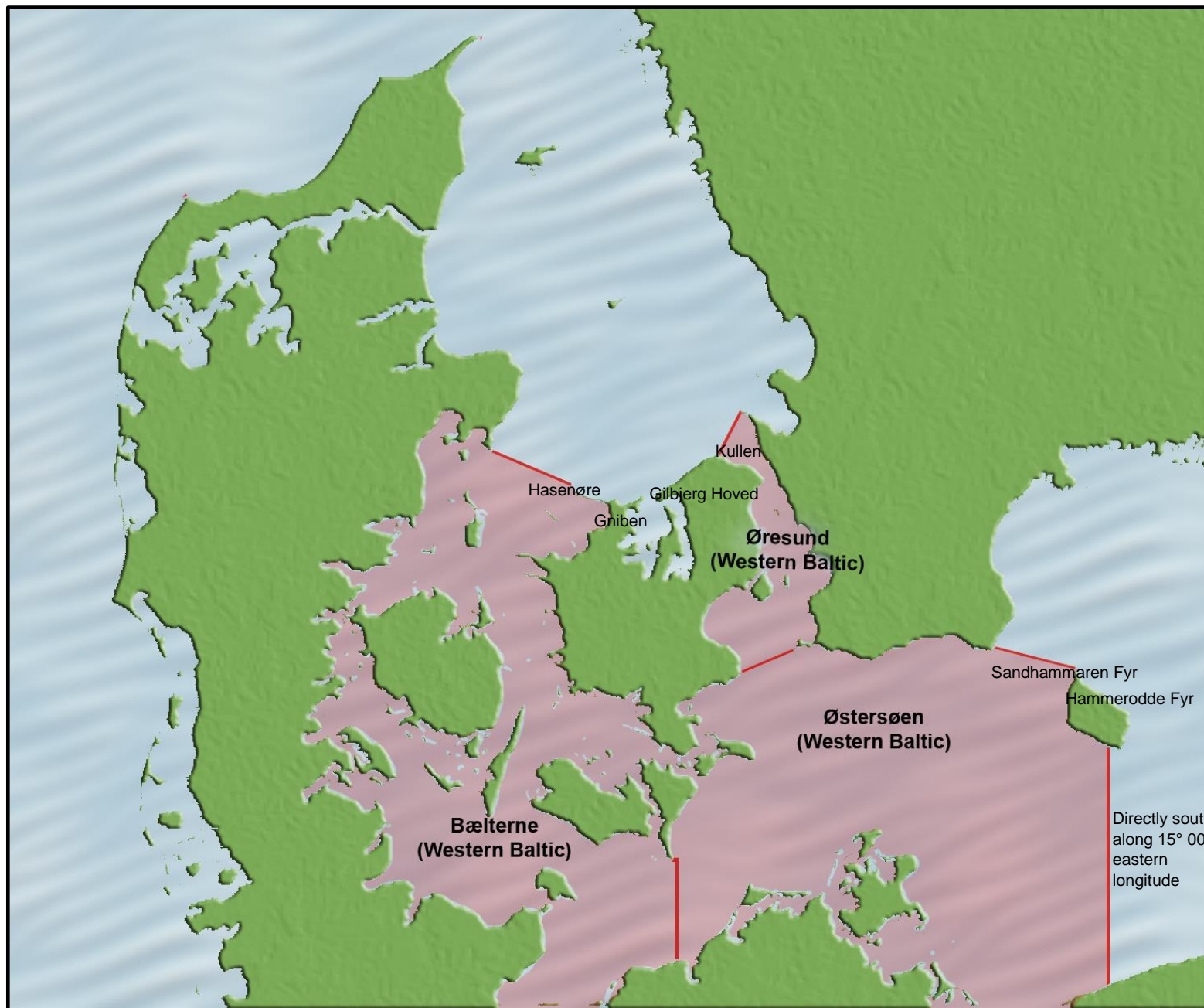

In 2019, anglers in the western Baltic Sea must only retain a maximum of 7 cod a day!



If you are angling in the Western Baltic in 2019, you are only allowed to retain a maximum of 7 cod a day¹.

This regulation also apply if you go out angling from a tour boat.

Western Baltic is the red colored area on the map.

¹ Article 7 in the COUNCIL REGULATION (EU) 2018/1628 of 30 October 2018 fixing for 2019 the fishing opportunities for certain fish stocks and groups of fish stocks applicable in the Baltic Sea and amending Regulation (EU) 2018/120 as regards certain fishing opportunities in other waters
